Print Rally, 2016-present, was established as a unique retention and recruitment program aimed at involving middle and high school students by connecting them with mentorship opportunities provided by current MSU Texas students and alumni. Regional middle and high school teachers are invited to nominate their top students to participate in creating their own original design that will become wood relief plates. These wood relief plates are printed on paper and fabric multiple times by current MSU students and alumni. A complete set of all the relief prints are collected and exhibited by the Wichita Falls Museum of Art creating professional development opportunities for all the students and alumni participating. To date the Print Rally has contributed over 168 relief prints to the Wichita Falls Museum of Art's Educational Collection.
